## **SENIOR MIXED INVITATIONAL RULES 2024**

- \* Teams must be comprised of two men and two women, playing in alternating order. The skip may be male or female.
- \* Each team will play two 8-end games.
- \* The first draw will start at 08:30 AM sharp. A strict 2 hour limit will be enforced. A warning will be given 15 minutes before the scheduled game end-time, after which no new ends may be started.
- \* Makeup of first draws, ice sheet designation and rock colours will be determined by the Metcalfe Curling Club organizing committee. If possible, teams from the same visiting club will not play each other in the first draw.
- \* The second draw match-ups will be determined by first draw scores with the two highest scoring winners playing one another, the two lowest scoring losers playing one another and the low winner playing the high loser. If necessary, adjustments will be made by the organizing committee to ensure that no team plays another team twice.
- \* The Metcalfe Curling Club will assign the sheet and rock colour of each team's second game in an effort to try to ensure that teams play on a different sheet and with a different colour stone than they did in their first game.
- \* Final winners will be determined by the total score of both draws. In the event of a tie, the team that won the most ends will be declared the winner.
- \* The 5 rock rule will be in effect.

### **SCORING RULES:**

5 Points for a win

1/2 of game score to a maximum of 5

1 point per end

1/2 point for a blank end

Any ends that are not played will count as zero for both teams.

In the event of a tie in points the organizing committee will refer back to the score and if necessary, the ends.
